1. I think that we should go to two season and use July 4th as the break between the two seasons.

7. Go back to a shorter summer season. If you are on a struggling team the summer season last year was way too long.
8. During the 'Season' it makes sense that more than half of the team should be present before drafting additional players. With 11 field positions that would be 6, or the game is forfeit. The regular season game could still be played at the Managers options. However, during the playoffs i would recommend a minimum of 7 players be present or the game is forfeited.

## AAA

1. Concerning AAA I would like to see there be 6 players present per team, or they would forfeit. Instead of five players at this time.
2. SSUSA, the association that controls most of the senior tournaments we participate in, is going to a one and one pitch count in 2020, we might try it too.
3. Shorten the summer league back to the way it was. Many players do not like playing almost all the way to November, which I believe is going to cause problems finding adequate managers, at least in the AAA league, and maybe some players. By the time the AAA league got into tournament play, some teams were picking up 5 or players each game, which defeats the integrity of tournament play because the teams that started the season are not the teams in the tournament, which defeats the integrity of the summer league draft.
4. Do NOT attempt to stretch 5 teams into 6 again with a limited number of players. Do NOT begin the summer ball late again. it caused problems during the playoffs due to conflicts with players that were playing on tournament teams. This is for AAA, consider using volunteers to umpire the baseline. For reasons unknown to me this was discouraged last season and only utilized during the playoffs. Geriatric home plate umpires would not or could not move out of position (make an effort to run a little towards 1st base) to make the correct call----many were missed.
5. Majors summer season needs to be shortened. Playing 40+ games into mid-October was way too long. End the season in early September.

6. You need 3 people to make decisions how to run the season. Not just one head strong individual.
7. Less arguing when we had 2 umps per game.
