




#### Q2 When should the Summer Season (including playoffs) end?


















#### Q10 What should be the maximum age for Triple-A players?







Q11 Consider the two softballs — Ball 'A' and Ball 'B' — described below:Ball 'A' is harder than Ball 'B'. Because it is harder, it comes off the bat faster and, when batted squarely, carries about 5% to 10% farther than Ball 'B'. A 290-foot fly-out with Ball 'B' would be a 310-foot home run with Ball 'A'. 

# Q12 A team should forfeit a scheduled game if it does not have a minimum number of rostered players at game time. What is the minimum number that should be required to avoid a forfeit?




