

PSS BOD Meeting Minutes April 13, 2026.

Meeting called to order at 1PM

Motion to accept March minutes made by Jim Fisher seconded by Randy Kern approved by all.

Bill Bandi presented the March Treasurer's report and is included by reference.

Mark Adams membership report: 63 Majors, 72 (2A), 75 (3A), with no dropouts or refunds.

One Injury reported, umpire Steve Smith was hit with a foul ball resulting in a broken nose.

Randy Walters reports same color schemes from last year for sponsors. It will take 4 weeks to order shirts with the order taking place April 17th with hats being ordered April 14th. Cost for the shirts \$26 and hats \$20.

Randy Kern reports all four fields are available.

Charlie bought 1000 business cards.

Motion made by Mark Adams and seconded by June Cord, "that any non-player who umpires, is league coordinator and/or provides scorekeeping will not be subject to any league fees but will be required to sign the same waiver that players sign". Motion was approved by all.

For the 2026 draft it was reported that zero players were dropped from Majors, one from 3A, and none from 2A.

For 2027 a skills test will not be required. The three games a new player participates in will be considered an "evaluation period". League coordinators will determine during this evaluation period if the player is in the appropriate division.

June Cord reports PSS has a spot reserved for the 4th of July Parade and they are currently seeking Veterans and First Responders to participate.

Larry Richie was commended for presenting excellent umpiring clinics to the 'AAA' and 'AA' divisions.

It was reported that several pieces of player's equipment- three gloves and one bat- had "gone missing" from the 'AAA' field. It is unclear if any or all of the items had been stolen or misplaced. No similar incidents were reported in the majors or 'AA' divisions. The Board will monitor the situation. All three divisions have been alerted.
