

PSS BOD Meeting Minutes
March 9, 2026

Meeting called to order at 12:30

February BOD meeting minutes were approved and accepted.

Bill Bandi presented February's Treasurers report. No questions were presented and the report is attached for reference.

Mark Adams reported the following registrations:

60 Majors

76 AAA

70 AA

Randy Walters reports that 16 sponsors have been secured and is working on getting two more.

Randy reports the Parks and Rec. will be working on fields 1 and 4 sometime in May or the Summer. If and when work is done adjustments in field use will be required. The city disclosed possible tournaments which could affect some league games.

The 3A division will experiment with a pitcher's screen for Cactus league.

Larry Richey is developing an umpire class for a future Friday date for the 3A and majors. A similar umpire class is also planned for 2A.

The Board addressed a potential conflict arising from a growing mismatch between divisional registrations and available roster spots within each division. Agreement was reached among Board members and the three division coordinators that, based on current(March 9th) registrations, the Major Division would draft 60 players (anticipating 6 teams of 10), the AAA Division would draft 66 (anticipating 6 teams of 11), and AA division would draft 72 (anticipating 6 teams of 12).

1. Entering the 'AAA' draft
2. Playing as a replacement player (without priority pick-up) in Major Division pool.
3. Resigning from PSS (refund status TBD)
