Treasurers Report

Treasurer Bill Bandi sent board members the Treasurers report via e mail.
No members had any questions. Motion made to accept the report made by Steve and seconded by Bill, approved by all.

Discussion items:

- The Board was given via e-mail, changes to the registration form by Steve Buck and the waiver form. The Board suggested the following changes;
1. Start date from Jan 16th to late January since the start date depends on the City of Prescott.
 2. Division skill levels. Removed highly from “highly competitive”.
Removed “desiring less competitive” from AAA division.
Removed “desiring to play in a recreation league. Players must meet minimum skill requirements.”
 3. Removed the Tobin Tourn. From the volunteer list.
 4. Made early registration of \$70 an option for both new and returning players if paid on or before 2/1/2022

With these changes the Board will discuss the waiver form and registration form and finalize these and any other changes at the December meeting as to be available for the 2023 season.

There was discussion on the placement and tracking of new players. Each league coordinator currently keeps track of the 3 trial games a player has before having to pay.

Webmaster Jeff Stillman informed the Board of adding a classified section as well as the current days game status. Also working on being able to take payments online for registration as well as individual pages for each league (majors, 3A, 2A)

Doug informed the Board that the balls we were using at the start of the 2022 season (ASA rock) were going for \$75 a dozen which is up from the pre 2022 amount of \$65 a dozen but less than the \$105 a dozen just a few months ago.

Mark informed the Board that he would be posting info on the league in various community web sites in early January.

Janet informed the Board the banquet went well and was working on scheduling the Goldwater Ramada for the picnic in June.
